DAY 1- 20th AUGUST 2022

1st SESSION (11:00 AM - 1:00 PM)

- Host Started the meet with inauguration and lamp light ceremony followed.
- The National Advisor introduced the 65th Council Members to the General Council. and the National Secretary introduced the Headquarter Volunteers.
- The National President gave an introductory note.
- The FGBM coordinator gave a thank you note.
- ID cards were distributed and attendance was recorded.
- Complaints regarding the accommodations like boys peeping into the balcony of girls accommodations, toilets issues, separating boys and girls accommodations, etc. were taken up by the FGBM Coordinator.
- The National Advisor asked UD's What is NASA India. Many UDs showed active participation in sharing opinions. Then a few more questions were brainstormed.
- History of NASA was discussed.
- President explained regarding the IIA and how NASA was formed and how much power Usec and UD holds.
- National Advisor shared point of view that all events and meetings should eliminate food budget and provide stalls, because everyone gets his/her favorite food and also wastage of food is reduced
- It was questioned by questions like will it be economic? Do we get receipts for food reimbursement? And the availability of food? The President and Vice President replied by saying that the economy and availability of food will be managed by the host and receipts will be looked upon.
- Issues regarding budget, workshops were addressed. Issues with workshop registration were solved by airtable software.
- PH said if delegates are seen drinking or smoking or involving in any other prohibited activity will be thrown out from campus.

2nd SESSION (2:45 - 5:30 PM)

65th year th

- Z122 questions this amendment by saying what in constitution it is mentioned to have amendments to be done in IGBM to which Advisor replied that it can be done in any GBM and there is mistake made in the constitution and will be changed in E-copy and will be printed in next edition after 5 years
- Z601 asks where 15% of the money left mentioned to which National Secretary replies with it goes in the next year.
- Z690 asks about where is ANC refund listed in the audit to which the National Secretary replies that it takes 2 months to calculate everything and it is not possible to add in the current financial year.





- In 62nd year zone 4 had profit of 6 lakhs in ZNC which was given back to the association which should go ethically to ZNC of zone 4 or which will be discussed later.
- Z409 asked why website expenses were 8 Lakhs but last year 45 thousand to which
 the advisor replied that expenses were made for the website and are not yet ready
 and will take time.
- The networth of NASA including everything is around 7 crores.

• <u>Headquarters:</u>

- Z401 asked how much is the profit made from merchandise, National
 Treasurer said 85,000. eme discussion:
- The National Advisor asked the importance of theme and should we do this practice, Z122, Z505 explained the importance of theme.
- The National Advisor asked what the interpretation of the logo is? Z319, Z112,
 Z211, Z153 told what they interpreted.
- Advisor explained because of experience and knowing alot about association; Past President writes the theme.

• 64th Audit Presentation:

- The National Secretary presented the Audit Report of the 64th year, queries were taken up by the National Secretary and National Advisor.
- Explained Subscription fee and 13 colleges were refunded 65% in 62nd year and told we have 2 FD's, about financial year and 12A 80G requirement of spending 85% of income for tax relaxation.
- Z511 asked why lodging was not put in the audit to which NA replied that CA suggested putting it under Meetings expenses.
- The National President explains about the meeting of ECZC and traveling costs.
- Current food charges are 450 and the National Advisor proposed to increase it to 500 and the decision was passed with majority approval.
 - Z319, Z122 tells about the HQ is a place where official documents are kept and how the HQ room is.
 - National Treasurer explains the HQ volunteers experience from Junior volunteers to Senior Volunteers to TD to Treasurer to Secretary in 5 years of college.
 - The National Treasurer asked why we need the college to be HQ, Z122 replied it won't be related otherwise also we won't get Volunteers.
 - Z518 asked what issues HQ faces, National Treasurer replied that HOD changes for 2 years so some HOD's are not in favor of NASA otherwise it goes smoothly.





- The National President appreciates HQ work as people take ownership of things and that's how it works out smoothly as they pass information to the Treasurer, TD and Volunteers.
 - Having HQ at SPA Delhi gives identity to the association
 - They don't charge any maintenance or electricity charge or anything
 - Structure is based on the trust bases
 - HQ volunteers are trained from 1st year
- Z504 says that it is mentioned in the Constitution that HQ can be changed but there is no college with national importance and within 50 kms from the metropolitan city, which was replied by saying that there are some IITs, NITs and SPAs which fall into the same category. We can somehow change that but the college must be a government college because of a lot of issues like college shutting down or as HOD is the signatory for the bank account he/she can mislead.
- Z301 is interested in becoming HQ.
- Z122 suggests HQ to have a large campus so that Usec can go there and stay.
- The National Secretary asked about the Societies Act, ISBN; and explained it.
- Advisor suggested Usec to pull up the students, suggest sensitive discussions
- Z117, Z421 and other colleges were having problems with paying subscription fees as
 they had a lesser number of intake happening in the college. The issue was cleared
 by the National President by suggesting few things as this issue was a special issue
 only with few colleges.
- National Advisor explains about the OAN program and talks about the leadership

• Minutes:

- TD candidate Shreyash Shinde explains regarding the minutes, how they used to happen previously by writing all the conversations of every GC, how they happen now by just summarizing everything
- Minutes are written because everyone can refer to previous years minutes what happened at that time and also no stupid questions are asked.
- o Minutes are uploaded on the website.
- Minutes are also required for documentation of the meeting as we need to show what is going on in the meetings.

• NISF:

- Only 2 responses were received in the NISF
- Z520 suggests to dilute 2 criterias namely annual income and CGPA
- Advisor suggests to mail such issues to council not just mention them in the GBMs
- The cap income can be increased to 5 lakhs
- Z129 suggests that people were not able to participate due to less marks and unavailability of the marksheet.
- Advisor says that scholarships will be relaxed and the deadline will be extended and others can apply for it.





- The CPK trophy may be funded, says the National President.
- Plagiarism and Vandalism done by units won't be tolerated

3rd SESSION (6:30 - 9:00 PM)

• <u>Plagiarism:</u>

- National President asks the GC what should we do for the plagiarized (has been reviewed) submissions or jury briefs
- o ECZC discusses on the plagiarism
- o Z211 suggests disqualifying the entry and negative marking should be done.
- Advisor asks why ANDC gives bids to colleges to which Z604 replies that it is criteria for getting membership status.
- Z521 suggests that college should be blacklisted or removed. Z690, Z420, Z241 supported the suggestion.
- Presentation of Plagiarized bid was done and all the proofs were shown, the bidder (Z241) was asked to come forward and questioned, to which he replied that faculty made the brief who chose the moderator and Usec didn't know that, it was plagiarized.
- o After Discussion, Voting was done for second time
- The National Secretary announced that as the motion passed by the council Z241 is demoted to Observer college and they won't be participating in any other activities till they get a declaration letter signed by the brief moderator and explanatory mail regarding the same. If the same thing is repeated the college will be banned.

• Publications:

- National Advisor said publication will be put on the amazon maybe by the next year
- National President asked the GC to take Publications and Certificates

• Status of college:

- What can be done for member colleges doing nothing and observers doing work?
- The National Advisor explains about the membership status and gives time to think about the different criterias.
- Z114 suggests to demote the member college, Z535 suggested to have another achiever status granted to top performing colleges after the membership status
- National President suggest to give
 - Only Usec Certificate to Unit with less participation
 - Usec Recognition Certificate and Silver Medal to Unit with good participation







- Usec Appreciation Certificate, Gold Medal and letter of what he/she has did to Firm/College for Usec with very well participation
- ZP will make list for the Usec and then EC will take look at it and other parameters will be discussed later

- The Vice President announced that ID publication will be published and 2 Indian Arch editions will also be published this year.
- Treasurer asked if 7500 is enough for traveling to which everyone agreed that it's not enough and Food expenses were increased to 500.

3rd SESSION (06:45 PM - 9:00 PM)

ANC Bid Presentation:

Every unit was given 7 minutes to present their bid.

• <u>Z630 presented ANC Bid Presentation:</u>

- The VP said the presentation was great but they backed off last time because NASA had to suffer and look for another host.
- Usec of Z630 defended by saying at that time there was COVID because of which management rejected and they proposed to have the ANC in June which council rejected and they had no other option but to backoff.
- The 64th ANC coordinator had discussions on topics like security, mattress, plug points, dates, etc.
- Z158 asked about accessibility and seminar halls, Advisor cleared all the topics that College has enough facility to host, it's just the commitment of college which we question because of them whole NASA suffered and the calendar was pushed ahead
- The bid was accepted but GC considered what we all suffered because of college

• Z153 presented ANC Bid Presentation:

- Z153 poornima college bids for ANC along with ayojan college, where ayojan college will be proposing the volunteers while the event will be hosted in the Poornima itself.
- Advisor said that the council had already inspected the college and college has almost everything which we need.
- Advisor stated the reason for not giving a bid to the college last year was because of the lack of capacity of the auditorium.
- Usec was suggested to revise the presentation, food budget and menu and present tentative budget

Council opens the ANC bids again and asks colleges to submit bids by 10 days. Z164, Z187, Z610 were interested in the bidding.





• <u>Disqualification of college:</u>

- 64th ANC coordinator Z108 had best performance in the fashion and were supposed to win the fashion trophy
- One volunteer from the unit wore the Host volunteer ID card, when asked upon he said he is a Host college coordinator, later the unit was called and the issue was cleared. But the Unit was not disqualified because of this reason
- One more Volunteer was found out having illegal substances in the campus premises, later they were seized.
- The College was removed because during the performance one performer came with the glass lamp in his hand and then at the last he smashed it on the floor in front of the ramp and people were hurt, and because of that the entry was disqualified.

4th SESSION (10:30 PM -12:00 PM)

AUDIT REPORT OF 64TH ANC:

ANC treasurer for 64th year presented the audit of ANC

- Total delegation fee collected was 2.76 Cr and the amount received from sponsorship was 24L which was the highest amount in the history.
- After paying taxes usable amount was 2.34 Cr and total amount spent was 2.68 Cr so the loss was 24L which was not loss as such because the college had some standards to maintain the image of college and because of that they paid for excess things which were not proposed in the budget like inviting Benny Dayal.
- Advisor appreciated the work done by the college and the detailed audit that was proposed.
- ANC Treasurer said they have all the receipts for everything and they didn't give the caution deposit to units who did not have receipts.

.Amendment in the Constitution:

President announced that we have to make amendment

- Reads out the objectives of the constitution and proposes Nasa India shall foster leadership by meetings, programs and events.
- This was done because we need to show the expenses done for the meetings in the audit and it can not be just meetings instead we can say we are fostering leadership.
- Advisor explains how FCRA works and CA has advised to mention the objective.
- The National President suggested having the last clauses of objective namely 3.8, 3.9, 3.10, 3.11 to be added into the new **Principles Section** and adding the fostering leadership as well in the same section.
- Z122 proposes 3.8 to promote leadership





- Z117 Proposes the last 4 clauses to be added in Principles Section
- Amendment was done on 21/08/2022
- NAC Discussions began and different committee were split up

- o ZP3 explains about interdisciplinary activity coming by Usec regarding mails and requests to show some respect by greeting, apologizing and signatory is mandatory, without signatory (Name, Designation and College code) the





mail is not considered valid even if it is sent from the zcode assigned email address.
