

ANDC 2022 QUERIES- SET 2

1. Is it necessary to have the zone of site selection as a whole or there is a possibility for the zones to be in parts that sum up to 2 acres (+/-20%)?

If parts are allowed is there a limit for the number of parts?

A: Yes, it is necessary to have the zone of site selection as a whole and not in parts that sum up to 2 acres (+/-20%). Note- There is no restriction on the shape of the selected area.

2. In the video submission do we have to add the documentation of the site that we select for the project or do we only have to explain the purpose, Process, Design, Impact, learnings, etc. of the project.

A: The video can contain anything which presents study, analysis, learning, perspective most accurately and innovatively. (Note- All videos being submitted should be preceded by the External NASA Logo (3 seconds) and the entry code (3 seconds) followed by the contents of the video. The duration of the animation is not considered in the minimum and maximum limit of the video.)

3. In the report we have to portray the summary of the study analysis done through the forms (e.g. annexures 1 & 2) or we need to prepare a project report. Also, is there any more detail or specifications for the sheets of the report like the text size, fonts, etc.?

A: The format for the data collection report is Annexure 4 and is available to download through the drive link as in the brief.

4. Regarding the number of sheets it is mentioned in the brief to submit a total of 19 A3 Sheets plus one report, according to the brief we are to use 10 sheets for design and 5 sheets for the documentation, so the rest of the 4 sheets are to be used according to our need or they are to be counted in report sheets.

A: The report will not be counted in the number of sheets. The format for the data collection report is Annexure 4 and is available to download through the drive link as in the brief.

5. What does brief mean by term "building to street level"? Do we have to select a site that's connected to any historical building or can we go for any site that has a strong history in any way?

A: The phrase 'Building to street level' means the selected site can be focused on a building/street or an area.

6. Can the design proposal be repeated multiple times in the same or different areas?

A: The design proposal can design modules which are relevant to the site.

7. Is it necessary for the site of 2 acre to exist as a whole block or can it be broken into smaller sites over a larger area?

A: It is necessary to have the zone of site selection as a whole and not in parts that sum up to 2 acres (+/-20%). Note- There is no restriction on the shape of the selected area.

8. Is the video supposed to have a narrative and what is the size of video file allowed?

A: The video can contain anything which presents study, analysis, learning, perspective most accurately and innovatively. (Note- All videos being submitted should be preceded by the External NASA Logo (3 seconds) and the entry code (3 seconds) followed by the contents of the video. The duration of the animation is not considered in the minimum and maximum limit of the video.)

9. How large should the base map be, does it have to include the impact area?

A: The size of the base map, identified core zone to be limited to 2.0 (Two) acres ($\pm 20\%$), however the impact zone can extend beyond the identified core zone. (Note - The maps should be scaled to enable proper legibility)

10. How many sample points must be chosen for surveying?

A: The sample size/points can be chosen as per the requirement of the site and scope of the proposal.

1. What are the peculiarities the site should possess? Does the site have to be preoccupied?

A: Yes the site has to be preoccupied and fully functional with business as usual. The site selected should have contextual importance when compared with the city or the neighborhood. The site selected should have high significance w.r.t to the communities and the society and have a prominence in the urban fabric.

2. Would the end goal be Renovation or Complete Redesign of the impact zone?

A: The end goal is left to the outcome of the data analysis and the requirements of the site. It could be renovation, redesign, up-gradation, rejuvenation, renewal, adaptive reuse etc.

3. Can the sheets be composed manually?

A: The choice of doing sheets either manually or digitally is left to the discretion of the participating units, adhering to all the guidelines and submission requirements as specified in the brief. The entries will be assured pertaining to the submission guidelines and checklist for submission.

4. Does the report include the copy of the annexure and if not, then what format for the report has to be adopted?

A: The reports should have two segments

- **Part a)** being the whole project report from the site selection, to data analysis, to program identification to the design end product.
- **Part b)** being the raw data collected with the formats prepared by the participating unit referring to the annexure 1&2 provided in the drive link.

5. What has to be included under the data collection sheets and how does it differ from our documentation part?

A: The data collection will be systematically recorded data clearly showing the transformation of the space along timeline (Overall data compilation),

The sheets will comprise the raw data, analysis of the data in different layers and numerical in terms of graphical representation and giving the program outcome for the particular site being chosen.
